We are so fortunate to have Bramfield as our popular, 3-day, nonresidential Junior Camp destination. Bramfield provides a superb environment for our younger members to learn skills in all aspects of good horsemanship.

Junior Camp is primarily aimed at members who are aged 10 and below and provides three, full, rally-style days.

Children will be grouped together according to age and riding level. Friendship groups are always considered and accommodated wherever possible. Our older PWPC members will be on hand to help the coaches, as well as organise games and supervise break times.

Each day, we ask you to arrive no earlier than 9am and be ready, mounted, for tack and turnout inspection at 9.45am. The rest of the day comprises of two ridden sessions, a stable management lesson and supervised tack cleaning, although the timetable is always subject to weather and other variables! Lunch is not included in the price, and campers will need to bring their own pack lunch. The camp-day finishes by 4pm. Parents are required to stay throughout.

PLEASE NOTE: There will be no stabling or facility to pen ponies at Bramfield this year and all ponies will have to go home each day. Everyone attending Junior Camp is required to help either with the setting up on Saturday 27th July, or the taking down (date to be determined). Please consider this when you are registering your child and let Sue know which end of camp you are available to help.
